PROJECT CHILDFIND

WHAT IS CHILDFIND? Childfind is a screening program that helps in identifying children that may have needs concerning their development.

HOW OLD DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO BE? This screening is for children between the ages 3 to 5 years old that may have developmental needs.

WHEN IS THIS PROGRAM? The screening program begins in June 2006.

WHAT DOES THE SCREENING INVOLVE? A team of teachers, speech pathologists and nurse from the district will perform the screening program. The screening will include examination of a child's:

- ◆ Speech/Language/Hearing
- ◆ Vision
- ◆ Learning
- ◆ Motor skills (including gross and fine)

WHO SHOULD BE SCREENED? Any parent of a child residing in the Caesar Rodney School District area who has concerns regarding their child's development in the above areas should register their child for screening.

INTEGRATED FULL DAY PRE-SCHOOL CLASS

WHAT IS AN INTEGRATED PRE-SCHOOL CLASS? A preschool class consisting of children with special needs and possible role model children.

HOW OLD DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO BE? To be considered for this program the child must have a birth date between the months of September 1, 2001 and August 31, 2002.

IS THERE A COST FOR THIS PROGRAM? A tuition fee of \$100 per month will be charged for students chosen/asked to participate as a role model. **Bus transportation will NOT be provided.**

WHEN IS THE SCREENING FOR THIS PROGRAM? Parents wishing their child to be considered for this program must call: 697-3103 on or before Friday, May 12, 2006 to schedule an appointment for their child to be screened.
